To avoid eye injury, always wear safety goggles or a protective mask when using any equipment, hammer or similar tool. When equipment is under pressure or when objects are struck, chips or other debris can be thrown out. Make sure no one gets hurt by the debris that is fired before applying pressure or hitting an object. Wear eye protection that complies with ANSI Z87.1 and OSHA standards. Also wear hearing protection and gloves.

Lifting a heavy object can cause serious or fatal injury. DO NOT exceed the maximum rated capacity of lifting and positioning devices: Stay away from the area under a suspended load.

Make sure that the chain is not damaged and that the load is always balanced.

2. RELEVANT INFORMATION



The following instructions are a generic procedure for all MTG adapters for cable shovels, independent from the lip standard (WH/BK), the size of the adapter and its tooth system.

The images contained in this procedure may not correspond to the model used in each case.


3. INSTALLATION PROCEDURE




CAUTION: The installation of MTG products for cable shovels may require welding and/or grinding of the existing lip to return it to its original geometry and thus ensure proper tightening and performance.

To perform the reconstruction/recalibration of lips, it is mandatory to follow the MTG reparation instructions for rope shovels which describe the proper procedures for recovering the lip geometry by using MTG gauges. Please contact technical.services@mtg.es for further information.

Place de adapter on its station assuring contact on the curved edge of the lip.




3.2 Introduce the C-Clamp in the proper position. Always with the handle from the inside of the dipper.







The IW (inverted wedge) is supplied properly assembled and torqued. However, if for any reason it has been manipulated or disassembled, the nut must be reassembled and retightened to a torque of 200 Nm (147 lb · ft). Impact socket size hex. 36mm (17/16 inch)






3.4 Insert the inverted wedge into its position.










Finally, insert the mounting bolt (tool) and screw it with an impact gun up to a torque of 1100 Nm/812 lb·ft. Use socket size hex. 22mm (7/8inch).


When the mounting bolt and wedge does not go down anymore, unscrew the mounting bolt and remove it from the assembly.

After installation, the wedge should protrude [X] between 100mm - 140mm (4 inches - 5.5 inches). If the wedge protrudes more than 140mm (5.5 inches) from the adapter, the assembly is not satisfactory. On the other hand, if the wedge protrudes less than 50mm (2inches), the size 2 wedge (oversize) must be installed. Insert the cap.













4. REMOVAL PROCEDURE


Remove the cap and clean the space between the wedge and the adapter until the removal nut is visible. Then, unscrew the nut of inverted wedge using an impact gun. Impact socket size hex. 36mm (1 17/16 inch).



Remove the nut and the inverted wedge's plate. Then, slightly hit the inverted wedge top surface until it falls through the hole. After that, the wedge and the c-clamp will collapse too.



4.3 If the C-clamp does not fall on previous step, it can be pushed through the hole. Then the adapter can be removed.
